










Operations: Map of inspector areas




- 260 Vehicles



- Litter Enforcement
- Litter Prevention
- Community Engagement and support



Litter Enforcement

- Litter Enforcement Manager & 12 Litter Wardens (In process of recruiting additional 6 litter wardens, 2 for night time economy)
- Enforcement of:- Litter Pollution Act; Storage, Presentation (kerbside) &Segregation of Household &Commercial Waste; Bye
 Laws for Prevention and Control of Litter
- Typical enforcement activity: Littering; illegal dumping; presentation of kerbside waste;
 Compliance campaigns door to door enquiries
 (household/commercial e.g licensed premises, food outlets) etc
- Fines: €150 under Litter Pollution Act,
 €75 under bye-laws, escalate in court up to €4k. (1600 fines issued in 2023)



Litter Prevention

Implementation of CCTV scheme across the city and manage prosecutions

Project 1: North east Inner City, 3 sites

Project 2: All Bring Bank Locations

- Preparation of Litter Management Plan (3 year plan)
- Coordination of Anti Dumping Initiatives in conjunction with Area Office
- Ensure Litter Management Plans in place for all events e.g;
 Womens Marathon, Dublin Marathon, St Annes Park, Royal
 Hospital Kilmainham events etc
- Implementation of Litter Awareness/Prevention Campaigns (e,g dog fouling, leave no trace), anti litter and graffiti schemes

 Green-Schools Programme - Environmental Education Programme for all schools (known globally as Eco-Schools)

Recycling Services

- +20,000 tonnes of material recycled in 2023
- 3No. CA sites, 8No. bring centres and 84 Bring Banks
- Civic Amenity (CA) Sites, additional waste streams, hazardous waste etc
- Reviewing CA gate fees in 2025








Challenges Facing the WM Service

- increasing population,
- increasing economic activity, service requests (>30,000/year)
- tonnage of litter collected (18000t/year)
- Illegal dumping (c. 3500t/yr)
- Consequences of Deposit Return Scheme
- Results of litter surveys (IBAL) and need to improve, reputation of city







